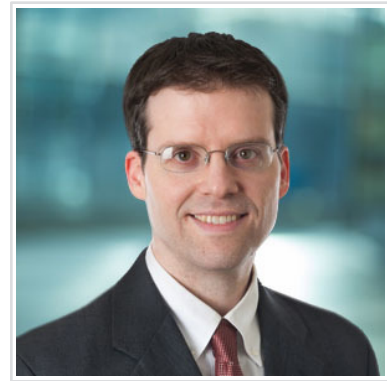


Luke A. Repici
