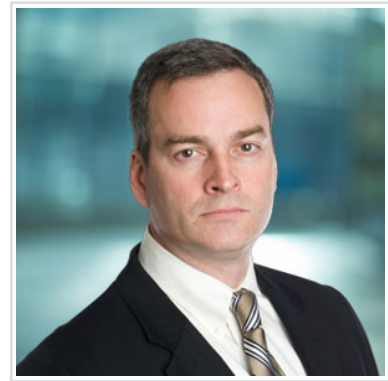


Robert Campbell

- Obtained summary judgment for an insurance producer after its client, a condominium association, suffered an under insured fire loss
