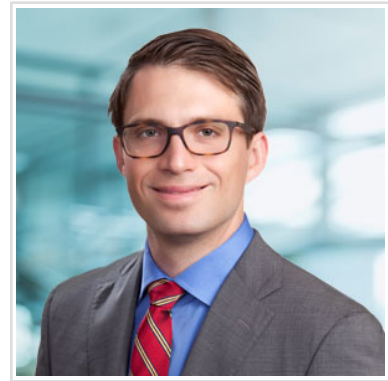


**Austin D. Moody**
