



## COVID-19 State and Business Reopening Resource

As of May 20, 2020, all 50 states have begun to ease restrictions imposed on non-essential businesses due to COVID-19. Each individual state is taking its own approach towards “rolling back” restrictions on these business' operations, and, in general, the degree to which operations can start back up is based on local levels of transmission and the need to take an incremental approach. Accordingly, reopening does not mean that things will return to how they were prior to the COVID-19 pandemic.
