Philadelphia | *George W. Childs School*

We proudly donated \$10,000 to the George W. Childs School towards the purchase of brand new schoolyard equipment, including tricycles, games, picnic tables and outdoor storage. Lehigh Valley | *Thomas Jefferson Elementary*

We kicked-off the adoption of Thomas Jefferson Elementary School with a donation of an educationally based Lego Wall, Legos and storage bins for the school's library. The donation supports the school's commitment to evolve their traditional library practices into makerspace workstations for their students. First Annual Eagles Autism Challenge

Team White and Williams braved the elements to bike, walk and run in the First Annual Eagles Autism Challenge.
