

ALI Restatement of the Law - Liability Insurance: Lessons Learned After Three Years

It has been three years since the American Law Institute approved its Restatement of the Law, Liability Insurance. For several years, while the RLLI was being drafted, there was substantial debate over the impact that it could have on the availability of coverage. Questions still remain. But dozens of courts have now spoken on the issue.

In this webinar, White and Williams counsel, Randy Maniloff, will examine how courts have addressed the RLLI. The webinar will also identify a pattern that has emerged in these decisions. Through this, some courts have demonstrated how parties in coverage litigation can use the RLLI to advance their arguments.

Other topics include the background of the RLLI, its key aspects, legislative responses and some landmines that may be awaiting insurers.
